Neither the Show Committee nor any person acting on their behalf will accept liability for any loss, damage or illness to ponies, horses, dogs spectators or any other person entering the show ground. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For those measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey instructions of all organisers, officials and stewards. All riders must wear appropriate dress in each class (i.e. riding jacket, shirt and tie or stock, jodhpurs or breeches, riding boots or jodhpur boot). For safety reasons everyone, whether a competitor or not, whilst mounted must wear a hard hat with a three point fixing, to British Standards ENI384, ASTMF 1163 or PAS015. The show committee would advise riders to wear a back protector to BETA Standards. The Show reserves the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason. If there is insufficient entries in any class, prize money will be withheld. Please ensure that no litter is left on the field. No lunging to take place in the warm ups / collecting rings on the show ground. All vehicles are parked at the owners risk. No cantering on the showground except in warm up areas. The judges decision will be final. Any objections must be made in writing to the show secretary accompanied by a deposit of £20 within 30 minutes of the alleged incident taking place. If the objection is unfounded by the show committee, then the deposit shall be forfeited. No refunds will be made on entries unless the class is cancelled. The show committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any class without stating a reason. All ridden horses / ponies must be 4 years old or over. All dogs must be kept on a lead whilst on the show ground and under control at all times. Stallions and colts are not allowed on the showground in the interest of health and safety.
