Class 51 Warm Up Stakes. Fences not to exceed 2ft.

Class 52. Pony Novice Stakes. For ponies 14.2hh and under. Riders any age.
Combination NOT to have won more than three First prizes in Show Jumping competitions. Fences in first round will not exceed 2ft 3”.

RULES.

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The Committee will not be responsible for any accidents to persons, animals or property.

The judge's decision is final.

All riders must wear hard hats at all times. NO GALLOPING OUTSIDE THE RINGS.

No person to be allowed in ring except Judges, Officials and Competitors.

Any objections to be handed into the secretary within half an hour of the class, together with a £50 deposit which is forfeited if the objection is not sustained.

The committee shall have the power to refuse or cancel any entry that has been made.

Prize money for the 2nd & 3rd places will be withheld should the number entered in any class be less than five. Classes may be amalgamated.

No entry money will be returned should the competitors be unable to take part in their class.

Prize monies to be collected on the day. All dogs to be kept on a lead at all times.

HEALTH & SAFETY. The committee has taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the Health, Safety and Welfare of those attending the show. 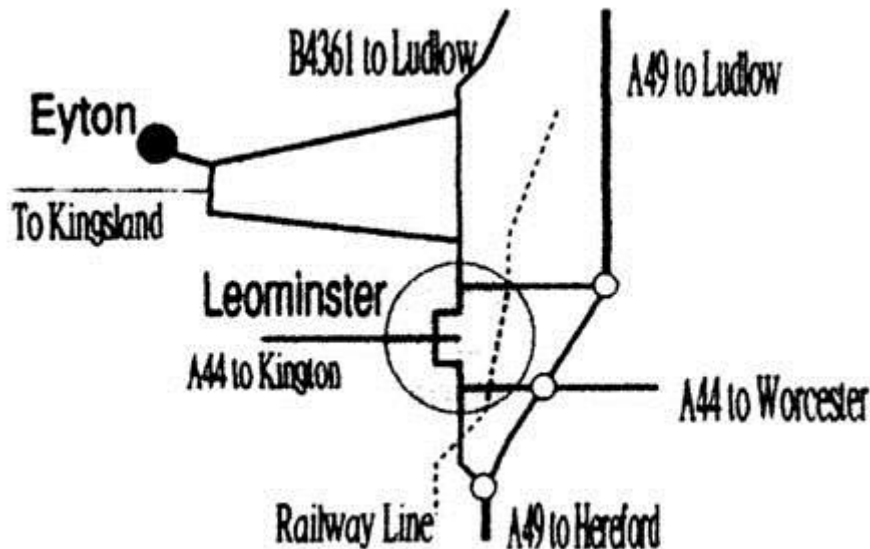
