SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The Judges decision is FINAL.
- 2. Ages as of 1st January 2015.
- Correct riding dress must be worn by all competitors. Everyone mounted, whether a competitor or not, must wear a riding hat complying with the current BS standard with the harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination.
- 4. The Organisers reserve the right to accept or reject any entry, to disqualify any rider considered to be under-horsed or unethical in any way, to cancel the show, to limit, cancel or amalgamate any classes, to change the timetable or to appoint substitute Judges without prior warning.
- 5. Horses and ponies under 4 years may only be shown in-hand
- 6. No entry fee will be refunded, except on production of a medical or veterinary report.
- 7. No claim can be entertained for anything which may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or animals, in connection with the show.
- 8. Once a competitors entry has been accepted it will be assumed that they will take part in that event unless he/she notifies the organisers or judges to the contrary.
- 9. It is a condition of entry that such entrant shall indemnify the Organisers against any legal action arising from any accident or incident at the show.
- 10. All entrants to the show must have third party insurance and be able to show proof of this if required.
- 11. Any objections arising from any incident in any class or event must be made in writing to the Secretary with a deposit of £10.00 within half an hour of the class or event concerned having been completed. This deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 12. All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- 13. All stallions and colts must be correctly bitted at all times.
- 14. Basic First Aid cover is provided by way of qualified First Aiders.

 Ambulance cover is by 999 call only so people ride at their own risk.
- 15. Ponies are not to be left unattended when tied up to trailers or lorries in the car park.
- 16. Children must be properly supervised at all times.
- 17. Please do not leave rubbish or muck your trailers out on the show field as the sanctuary donkeys need to use the field.


#### **EQUINE HOSPITAL APPEAL**

It has long been the ambition of Island Farm Donkey
Sanctuary to have a purpose built unit where donkeys can
receive veterinary treatment in a warm, safe, sterile
environment. Anyone who has kept a pet will know that at some
point they will probably need to see a vet and with
rescued animals this is even more necessary.

Upon arrival at the sanctuary all donkeys are given an examination to assess their health and condition. With this knowledge we can plan what needs to be done to be able to start them on the (sometimes slow) road to recovery and rehabilitation.

We desperately need a facility to treat ill or injured donkeys because at the moment, if a donkey cannot be treated on site, they need to be transported to the vets. With it's own equine hospital established at Island Farm the vet can treat the donkeys and maintain their aftercare in a sterile recovery stable.

The Equine Hospital will be available for the treatment of donkeys and ponies up to 14.2 hh by mutual arrangement between the owner's vet and the Sanctuary's vet. Procedures such as gelding, sarcoid removal will be available by our vet. Fees will apply.
