





4 Special Rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed adult members wearing a silk hat, bowler hat or safety hat and the highest placed junior member of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card.

N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn by Adults IN THIS CLASS ANY TIME OF DAY. Juniors **must** wear hats to current British Safety Standards or above for this class. Adult riders **NOT** wearing such hats do so at their own risk.

Class 604 CLASSICAL LADIES SIDE SADDLE QUALIFIER

Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cms (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, by a SHBGB, BSHA, BSPS, P(UK) or SSA Panel Judge. Judges may request a short show, but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. N.B. Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided.

The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. Special rosettes are offered by Mrs. T. Mitchell to the winner and if the winner has already qualified, a second rosette is awarded with the Qualification Card. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final.Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and The next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only.

The highest placed Riding Horse, Hack (not exceeding 160cm), Cob or Hunter, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualifies for The 2016 BSHA Championship Show Total Impact Equestrian Ladies Show Horse Championship and if already qualified the ticket will go to the next highest placed horse down to 5th place. The qualification period is 1st January, 2016 to 11th September, 2016. SSA Members who qualify for The Ladies Show Horse Championship, will not be required to join the BSHA in order to compete in any Side Saddle class at the BSHA National Championship Show. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward to the following year. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship.

The Promoters, Organisers, Committee and Landowners ('The Committee')shall not be liable for any claim in respect of any damage to any person, horse or other property of any land howsoever it may have been caused. It is an express condition of entry, that each competitor shall hold the Committee harmless and that he or she shall indemnify the Committee against any legal proceedings, actions, expenses, costs, claims, demands or damage whatsoever arising from any accident or other incident which may occur.
- 2. All vehicles parked at their owners risk.
- 3. Entries to be accompanied by the appropriate fee, and will not be acknowledged unless an SAE is enclosed . Numbers to be collected from the Secretary on the day.
- 4. No refund of entry fee unless the Show has to be cancelled for any reason. Should this be deemed necessary the Organisers reserve the right to retain up to 50% of any entry fee paid to cover the pre-Show expenses.
- 5. The Judges decision is final.
- Any objection must be handed to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes.of the alleged incident accompanied by a £25.00 deposit which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
- 7. No unauthorised person allowed in the Show ring.
- 8. Hard hats must be worn at all times when mounted and by Young Handlers.
- 9. No galloping allowed on the Show-ground. This includes the parking areas.
- 10. All dogs must be kept on leads.
- 11. Foals must be at least four weeks old and accompany their dams, into the Show-ring.
- 12. All stallions and colts must be bitted. Yearling colts may be led from the nose-band with a bit in the mouth.
- 13. It is recommended that all entries have been inoculated against equine influenza.

TSR HORSEZONE.CO.UK Regional Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2016 TSR HORSEZONE.CO.UK Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You do not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSRHORSEZONE.CO.UK Riders Finals - 1st - 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR HORSEZONE.CO.UK InHand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk

National Pony Society Affiliation Rules 2016

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 2nd -4th August 2016

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

Traditional Gypsy Cob Association (TGCA)

These classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS", held annually in September. Full details can be obtained from www.tgca.co.uk. Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) In order to enter any TGCA affiliated class, must be licensed with the TGCA prior to the show AND have their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non members will receive a qualification card from the judge and will have 21 days to join the TGCA and to register their horse in order to validate this. TOYS Qualifications will be awarded to the top three youngstock, small senior IH, large senior IH, small ridden, large ridden and to the highest placed junior and restricted exhibitor. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

ROR/TARRA Ridden: Open to all Weatherbys (or relevant foreign thoroughbred authority) registered Thoroughbreds raced or unraced (passports may be checked) 4yrs and over owned and ridden by an amateur. Racing name of horse to be used on entry form. Horses must be registered with ROR and have a ROR number which should be stated on the entry form. Class will be judged under a 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration. Injuries and blemishes caused through racing will be ignored. The first three horses will qualify. The judge may Ride. This is a qualifier for the TARRA Ridden Championship at Aintree, August 2016.

1st - 4th rosettes with a prize for 1st place.

ROR/TARRA In-Hand: Open to all Weatherbys (or relevant foreign thoroughbred authority) registered Thoroughbreds raced or unraced (passports may be checked) any age owned and shown by an amateur. Racing name of horse to be used on entry form. Horses must be registered with ROR and have a ROR number which should be stated on the entry form. Class will be judged under a normal in-hand format with injuries and blemishes caused through racing will be overlooked. The first three horses will qualify and qualification will pass down to fourth place only. This is a qualifier for the TARRA In-Hand Championship at Aintree, August 2016.

1st - 4th rosettes with a prize for 1st place.

ROR/TARRA Amateur definition 2016: An individual who does not receive any remuneration from the showing, riding or production of show horses in the last 5 yrs, sponsorship included. Individuals employed in other equestrian disciplines shall be classified as amateurs for the sake of the TARRA show series. Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and may result in disqualification from future classes.

The Show Committee reserves the right to change the Judges, without prior warning, and to divide, cancel or amalgamate classes if deemed necessary.
