


SHOW RULES

 All riders on the showground, whether competing or not, are strongly recommended to wear hard hats complying with PAS 015/EN 1384.
- 4. Competitors must not ride recklessly around the showground.
- 5. The organisers reserve the right to alter the rotation and timing of any class, to cancel any class or to change the judge of any class.
- Objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the class ending, accompanied by a £20.00 fee, to be returned only if the objection is upheld.
- 7. No entry fee will be refunded in any class without the submission of a valid Doctor/ Veterinary Surgeon's certificate.
- 8. The organisers committee or landowners shall not be responsible for any accident, damage or loss however caused that may occur to any exhibitor, persons or any animal, article or property whilst on the showground or whilst entering or leaving.
- 9. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to a class and to the showground.
- Any vehicles brought onto the showground must be manoeuvred and parked as directed by the Stewards.
- 11. The onus is on every rider who suffers a fall, or anybody who suffers an injury whilst on the showground, to report the fall/injury to the Show Secretary.




