- ❑ **Withdrawals:-** In the unfortunate event of withdrawal, please advise the Secretary by Mid-day Tuesday prior to the competition. We regret **no refunds** will be made after this time.
- ❑ **Times: Please ring 07563621050 on FRIDAY 18TH AUGUST between 7.30 & 9.00pm**
- ❑ Any special requests must be clearly put onto entry form
- ❑ Classes will be judged under BD rules and correct dress must be worn.
- ❑ Commanders allowed for all dressage tests.
- ❑ Horses may only enter once in each class competitively.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever. The organisers' decision is final.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

Please do not tie your horse/pony to any showground fencing
