**Safety hats to current safety standards must be worn whilst mounted by all Junior and Adult competitors at all times. For exceptions see Class rules**

#### **Class 16. Novice Equitation Class**

Open to Adult and Junior rider/horse combinations who have never competed in a Side Saddle Equitation Championship Class at any National Show. A short simple show will be required. Habits need not be worn and horses may be shared. (*Qualifying Points for Equitation Championship classes at the SSA National Show are not awarded in this class*)

#### **Class 17. The Side Saddle Association Equitation Championships**

##### **Open Qualifying Class**

Run under SSA rules defined in the current Members' Handbook

Open to SSA Members and Non-Members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA Championship Points.

**Southernden Side Saddles** sponsor a rosette to the highest placed Member aged under 14 on 1st January of the current year. A rosette sponsored in memory of **The Late Mr R Philpot** is offered to the Adult Member and **Just So Elegant Side Saddle Hire** sponsor a rosette for the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out. The highest placed rider aged 45 years or over receives a Special rosette kindly sponsored in memory of the **Late Constance, Lady Bayliss**

##### **Qualifier for the Sir Lancelot Memorial Trophy & Lady Guinevere Trophy**

A Special rosette will be offered to the Adult Member, carrying their current Championship Points Card, **of the SSA Area in which the Show is organised**, who during the Equitation Qualifier Class (irrespective of final placing) is judged to be the most elegant. That Member will be eligible to compete in the Final for the Sir Lancelot Memorial Trophy (donated by the late Mrs E. Skelton) at the National Side Saddle Show. A Member may only qualify once per season between one National

Show and the next, and if the Judge's first choice has already qualified, the rosette will be awarded to the next eligible competitor.

A Special rosette will be offered to the Junior Member, who during the Equitation Qualifier Class (irrespective of final placing) is judged to be the most elegant. That Junior Member will be eligible to compete in the Final for the Lady Guinevere Trophy at the National Side Saddle Show.

### **Class 18. The Classical Ladies Side Saddle Qualifier**

Open to SSA Adult Members and Non-members, aged 18 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cm (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners and & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider. Judges may request a short show, but horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. **NB** Silks Hats are permitted to be worn in this class AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, the Qualification Card may be passed down to fourth place. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. One special rosette and the qualification card will be given to the qualifying combination at rider. each show, this may not always be the winner. If the winner has already qualified they may be passed down to fourth place. Qualifiers kindly sponsored by **Mrs. T. Mitchell and Mr. L. Mitchell**. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show, or as soon as possible if qualified after that date, to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only. The four highest placed **Riding Horse, Hack** (not ex 160cm), **Cob or Hunter**, Mare or Gelding, 4 years and over, ridden by a SSA Adult Member qualify for the current year's **BSHA Championship Show Mears Ladies Show Horse Championship**. Combinations qualifying after the current year's BSHA Championship Show may carry forward the qualification, to the following year. **SSA Members** who qualify for **The Mears-Wood Family Ladies Show Horse Championship**, will not be required to join the **BSHA** in order to compete in any **Side Saddle class at the BSHA National Championship Show**. If the BSHA Championship Show entries have closed at the time of qualification, competitors will not be charged a late entry fee for the Championship.

### **Class 19. The Contemporary Ladies Side Saddle Qualifier**

Open to SSA Adult and Junior Members and Non-members riding a Native, Part Bred, Heavy or World Breed horse / pony side saddle. To be judged 25% suitability of horse/pony for rider, 25% manners and way of going for type, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider. Conformation will not be taken into consideration. The Judge will request a short show. Traditional habits must be worn. **N.B.** Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. One special rosette and the qualification card will be given to the qualifying combination at each show, this may not always be the winner; if the winner has already qualified they may be passed down to fourth place. Qualifiers kindly sponsored by **The Langley Family**

Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the SSA 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show or as soon as possible if qualified after that date to be eligible to compete at the Final. Combinations qualifying between one National Side Saddle Show and the next may carry forward the qualification, for that year only.

**PLEASE NOTE YOU MAY ONLY ENTER EITHER THE CLASSICAL OR THE CONTEMPORARY CLASS AT SHOWS AND ONLY QUALIFY FOR ONE OF THE FINALS UNLESS YOU HAVE TWO HORSES/PONIES OF A DIFFERENT TYPE**

### **Class 20. Best Horse or Pony Ridden Side Saddle.**

Open to horses or ponies 4 years old or over: conformation & manners will be taken into consideration; horses/ponies will not be stripped. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards.

**The Highest placed** coloured exhibit ridden by a competitor aged 16rs or over (**who has not already qualified**) receives a **Qualification Card** and qualifies for the **Side Saddle Final** at the CHAPS Championship Show. **Open to any type of exhibit. Riders/Owners need not be a member or their exhibit registered with CHAPS at the time of qualification, but in order to compete at the Championships, the Rider/Owner must be a showing member and their horse/pony registered with CHAPS before entering the final.**

Lead rein riders are eligible for this class. Leaders must be correctly dressed

### **Class 21. Side Saddle Concours d' Elegance**

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse/pony and rider, and the way of going of the horse/pony. Safe tack must be used. Detailed inspection of the rider's period costume is not required. Fancy dress is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the judge may ask small groups of riders to give short displays. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Card. Competitors should produce a brief resume about their costumes for the commentator.

Adult riders not wearing safety hats do so at their own risk.

### **Side Saddle Overall Championship 4**

Open to competitors placed 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in any of the above classes.

Championship and Reserve sashes and rosettes will be awarded.

### **Rosettes.**

Area 5 rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place in all classes

Special Area 5 rosettes to all Juniors who have not competed side saddle before.

### **Area 5 Show Points Awards**

To the Adult and Junior Area 5 Member of the SSA gaining the most points in the current year at the Area 5 KOME Novice Training Show, Area 5 Spring Show at the H.O.P.E Show, Area 5 Summer Show with Atherstone & District R.C. Show and the Area 5 Autumn Show on the same horse/pony.

Points will be awarded as follows:

6 points for first place, 5 points for second place and so on down to 1 point for sixth place

To be presented at the Area 5 AGM.

### **Rules**

1. All classes shall be ridden side saddle and run under SSA Rules, SEE CURRENT SSA HANDBOOK

2. Classes may be divided for the purposes of preliminary judging if numbers require

3. Judges' decisions are final

4. **Entries close 11<sup>th</sup> March.** LATE ENTRIES will be accepted if classes are not already full, at an additional cost. (see H.O.P.E. Schedule)

5. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry and to alter, amalgamate or cancel classes

6. All dogs to be on non-extending leads

7. All competitors and those in attendance are reminded of their individual responsibilities with regard to Health & Safety, not only to themselves but others on the show ground. This responsibility extends to safe parking of vehicles and management of horses/ponies.

8. No responsibility will be accepted by SSA Area 5 for any accident howsoever it is caused

9. Falls. A fall of horse/pony or rider in any class run under Side Saddle Association rules will result in disqualification, and the rider must leave the ring dismounted. It is strongly recommended that medical advice is then sought before competing in any other class

### **CHAMPIONSHIP 11 - BEST OF THE BEST QUALIFIER**

#### **SHETLAND PONY STUD BOOK SOCIETY SHOWING RULES**

Classes 32-37 must be confined to SPS-BS registered ponies. Ponies must be named on the entry form and in the catalogue of one is produced. Society rosettes must only be given to ponies registered with the society or to foals eligible for registration.

Three year old fillies with foals at foot may not be shown. All foals must be a minimum of three weeks old on the day of the show.

To enter a stallion in any class in hand or performance at an affiliated show, all males aged four years old and over must have an 'S' number and have been successfully through either the SPS-BS stallion assessment prior to 2000 or the current SPS-BS voluntary veterinary examination. written stallions must display a stallion bridal badge. In hand Colts/Stallions of two years old and over must be shown bitted and our advice to display a colt or stallion badge. These are available to purchase from the SPS-BS.

There must be no colts or stallions in Young Handlers classes. Young handlers must be a minimum of three years of age on the day of the show. Children under 14 years old may not show colts (excluding foals) or stallions in In Hand classes.Children aged under 12 years old on the day of their class may not show a stallion in ridden classes.In the interests of safety, hard hats conforming to current British safety standards must be worn,correctly secured, by all handlers aged 14 years or under in in hand classes.For health and safety purposes judges and exhibitors must remain standing whilst in the Ring when showing ponies. KNEELING IS NOT PERMITTED.Hard hats conforming to current British safety standards must be worn, correctly secured, by all exhibitors, irrespective of age, in ridden classes. Ridden and driven ponies must be four years old or over.In ridden classes, If a rider falls off at any time whilst in the ring, both Pony and rider must leave the ring, rider dismounted, and take no further part.

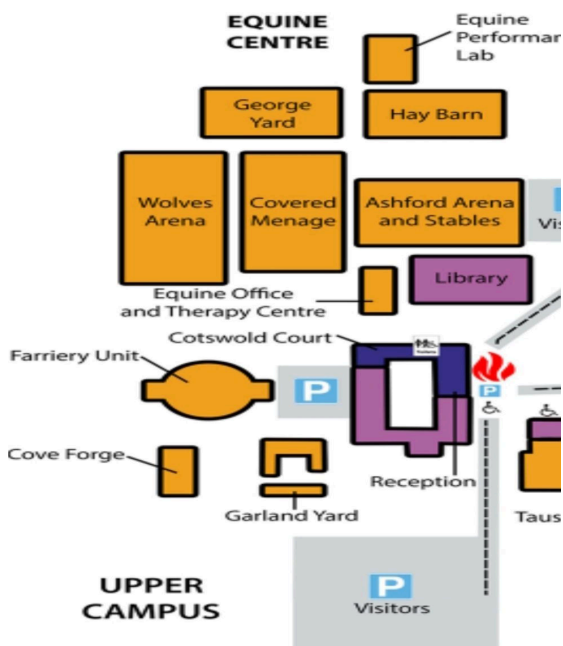

2. All vehicles parked at their own risk.
3. Entries to be accompanied by the appropriate fee which will not be acknowledged unless an SAE is enclosed. Numbers to be collected from the secretary on the day.
4. No refund of entry fee for any reason unless the show has to be cancelled. Should this be deemed necessary, the organisers reserve the right to retain up to 50% of any entry fee paid to cover pre-show expenses.
5. The judges decision is final.
